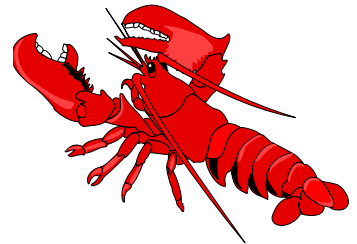

## The History

2010 marks the **16<sup>th</sup> anniversary** of Evening in the Maritimes, a fundraiser for Citizen Advocacy of Ottawa. At the very first Evening in the Maritimes on May 24, 1995, close to 500 people gathered in the Aberdeen Pavilion to enjoy a wonderful seafood dinner, modelled after a **traditional East Coast lobster supper**, and to be entertained by the Irish Descendants from Newfoundland. From the first event, which raised \$4,500, Evening in the Maritimes has grown into one of Ottawa's premiere fundraising soirées by remaining true to its theme: raising funds through an evening of **down-east fun**, food and entertainment. To date, this formula for fun(d) raising has raised close to **1.5 million dollars** for Citizen Advocacy!

## The Event

Evening in the Maritimes features a **5-course lobster dinner** modeled after the world-renowned Maritime lobster suppers. Fresh North Atlantic lobster, seafood chowder, salads and desserts make up the menu. Celtic entertainment by bands such as Rawlins Cross, John McDermott, and the Barra MacNeils creates the feel of an east coast **kitchen party**. A silent auction featuring extravagant jewelry, appliances, artwork, unique gift baskets, travel, golf, and other items raises funds for Citizen Advocacy, and an exclusive **balloon raffle**, with all balloons popped in unison, sees guests win trips such as \$1,000 cash, trips to Nova Scotia, and hot air balloon rides. **Honorary chairs** Bob Chiarelli (former Mayor of Ottawa) and Randy Pettipas (President and CEO of Global Public Affairs) welcome guests, and MC Kurt Stoodley, of A Ottawa television, hosts the evening.

## The Organization

**Bringing people together:** that's the real goal of Citizen Advocacy of Ottawa.

Since 1974, Citizen Advocacy of Ottawa has supported **over 2,000 people** with disabilities and touched the lives of many more. Because we work at an **individual** level, directly with the people we support, the impact is felt on a personal, as well as a community, level. Volunteer advocates help increase the **self-esteem and self-confidence** of persons with disabilities so that they can develop a better sense of overall health. This translates into less dependency and a reduction in the use of costly health and social services. There are currently more than 250 people with disabilities supported by Citizen Advocacy. Citizen Advocacy **supports people** with a wide range of disabilities, including physical limitations, developmental delays, mental illness, and disabilities related to age. The average length of a match is **over five years**, with some matches lasting over 30 years!

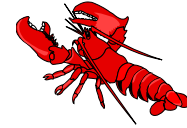

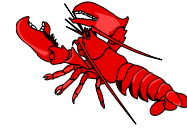
